2024 WRIGHT SPIRIT AWARDS NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

Introduced in 1991, the Wright Spirit Award recognizes extraordinary individuals and organizations that have preserved the legacy of Frank Lloyd Wright through their tireless dedication and persistent efforts. It is the highest accolade bestowed by the Frank Lloyd Wright Building Conservancy. The Wright Spirit Awards will be presented during the Gala at the Conservancy’s annual conference, which will take place in Detroit, Michigan, September 25-29. Each honoree will receive a Wright Spirit Award crystal, etched with a design created by Susan Jacobs Lockhart, courtesy of fabricator J. Charles.

Nominators must conform to the requirements outlined below in order for their nomination to be considered for a Wright Spirit Award. The Frank Lloyd Wright Building Conservancy reserves the right not to present an award in one or all of the categories during a given year. The Conservancy will notify you when your nomination has been received, and also of the final disposition once awards decisions have been made.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

- A completed Wright Spirit Award nomination form (the first page of this document). All complete nominations will become the property of the Frank Lloyd Wright Building Conservancy. Please note that incomplete nominations will not be accepted.
- A **concise 300-word description** of the project, program, organization, or individual that is being nominated and how the nominee fulfills the requirements for the individual category, attached as a separate 8.5” x 11” document.
- Up to 10 pages of supporting materials, including such items as photographs, newspaper or journal articles, brochures, and the like may be attached to the nomination. If possible, please format these for 8.5” x 11” printing. *Please do not send any original materials; scans or copies only.*
- **DEADLINE: Nominations must be RECEIVED by 5:00 p.m. Central time on Friday, March 29, 2024.**
